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ATTACHMENT E4 – DUST, TRAFFIC CONTROL AND ROAD CLEANSING

Dust Control

Water bowser provided on site to suppress dust on haul roads during dry conditions. The recovery activities are to take place within a natural depression in the topography of the surrounding area. This depression is also surrounded by a mature tree line.

Traffic Control

Speed limit signs of 15kms on site to slow HGV on and off the site. Traffic speed reduction on the public roadway which accesses the site has a speed reduction in place of 50kms. This public roadway will be downgraded from a primary road to a secondary for local access within six to eight months.

Road Cleansing

The applicant provides on site a mechanical sweeper for any necessary road cleansing.
