TRANSFER OF AN IPPC LICENCE

Decision of the Agency, under Section 94 of the Environmental Protection Agency Acts, 1992 to 2007.

IPPC Licence Register No: **P0412-01**

The Agency, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Environmental Protection Agency Acts, 1992 to 2007, for the reasons hereinafter set out, hereby transfers IPPC licence register number P0412-01 from Gortnamuc Pigs Limited, Gortnamuc, Kilcormac, County Offaly, to Harvest Lodge Pigs Limited, Kilcormac, County Offaly. IPPC Licence Register No P0412-01 licenses the carrying on of the IPPC activities set out below at Gortnamuc, Kilcormac, County Offaly, subject to eleven Conditions, as set out in the IPPC licence.

Activity Licensed :-

red :- the rearing of pigs in installations, whether within the same complex or within 100 metres of that complex, where the capacity exceeds 1,000 units on gley soils or 3,000 units on other soils and where units have the following equivalents; 1 pig = 1 unit, 1 sow = 10 units,

In accordance with Section 94 of the Acts, Harvest Lodge Pigs Limited is deemed to have assumed and accepted all liabilities, requirements and obligations provided for in or arising under the licence, regardless of how and in respect of what period, including a period prior to the transfer of the licence, they may arise.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Pursuant to Section 94(5)(a) of the Acts, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Harvest Lodge Pigs Limited is entitled to be regarded as a fit and proper person to be granted a like IPPC licence. Pursuant to Section 94(5)(b) of the Acts, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Harvest Lodge Pigs Limited has made adequate financial provision to discharge the financial commitments or liabilities that will be entered into or incurred in carrying on each of the activities to which the licence relates, or in consequence of ceasing to carry on any of those activities. In reaching this decision the Agency has considered the application and supporting documentation received from the joint applicants and the report of its inspector.
