## ***Reasons for the Decision***

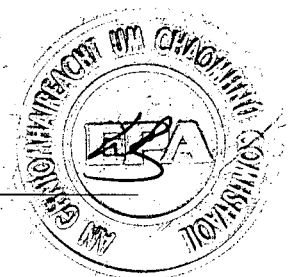
The Environmental Protection Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that subject to compliance with the conditions of licence Reg. No. W0030-02 granted on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2002, amended on 20<sup>th</sup> October 2005 (Technical Amendment A) and on 20<sup>th</sup> June 2008 (Technical Amendment B), as well as any amendments noted herein, any emissions from the activity will comply with and not contravene any of the requirements of Section 40(4) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2008.

## ***Technical Amendment***

In pursuance of the powers conferred on it by Section 42B(1)(c) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2008, the Agency amends Licence Reg. No. W0030-02, granted to Kilkenny County Council, at Dunmore Landfill, Dunmore, County Kilkenny.

Henceforth, the Licence (Reg. No. W0030-02) shall be read in conjunction with the Amendment A dated 20<sup>th</sup> October 2005 and Amendment B dated 20<sup>th</sup> June 2008 and the amendments set out below. This technical amendment shall be cited as Amendment C (in pursuance of Section 42B(1) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2008) to Waste Licence Register No. W0030-02.

This technical amendment is limited to the following Condition:



# Amendments

## Conditions of Licence

*Amend Condition 1.5.3 of the existing licence to read as follows:*

- 1.5.3** Subject to paragraphs (i) and (ii) below, only waste that has been subject to adequate pre-treatment (including source separation) is permitted to be accepted at the facility after 30<sup>th</sup> September 2009.
- (i) Treatment shall, as a minimum, reflect commitments in the Joint Waste Management Plan for the Southeast Region 2006-2011, as well as any EPA guidance as may be published.
  - (ii) This requirement may, subject to the agreement of the Agency, not apply to:
    - inert wastes for which treatment is not technically feasible
    - other waste for which such treatment does not contribute to the objectives of the Landfill Directive as set out in Article 1 of the Directive by reducing the quantity of the waste or the hazards to human health or the environment.
