## RE: Indaver Ireland Application for a Revision of the Waste Licence for the Meath **Waste Management Facility**

Indaver Ireland wishes to apply for a review of waste licence WL167-1 to increase the capacity of the proposed waste-to-energy plant at Carranstown from 150,000 tonnes per annum to 200,000 tonnes per annum (tpa). Other changes to the proposed development include the removal of the recycling centre and materials recovery facility in line with planning permission PL 17.126307, a revised layout of the facility and new design features in line with best practice.

The revised facility will consist of a 70MW waste-to-energy facility for the acceptance of 200,000 tpa household, commercial and industrial non-hazardous waste.
