K.1.1 Cessation of Activity

The total lifespan of the plant is currently anticipated to be 30 years. This may be extended through preventative maintenance and replacement of equipment. Therefore, detailed financial, administrative and technical provisions are not given here in the form of a decommissioning plan for the site.

Should circumstances arise whereby it becomes necessary to shut down the facility, Indaver will provide the EPA with a detailed decommissioning plan for its approval before any works begin. As outlined in Attachment L.2.3, financial provision will be made to secure final restoration measures if required under planning condition 28 of PL17.219721.

In the event of decommissioning, measures will be taken by Indaver to avoid any pollution risk and return the site of operation to a satisfactory state. Such measures are outlined in Section 5.15 of the EIS. Further to these measures, the site and buildings will be left in a secure manner and appropriate security will be maintained onsite in the event that the site is left vacant for an extended period of time.

As noted in Section 5.15 of the EIS, the absence of materials stored or landfilled onsite will mean that an aftercare management plan is not required.

K.1.2 Cessation of Activity Modifications

There are no modifications to the measures food cessation of activity approved in Waste Licence 167-1.

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
