### **Objection to Proposed Decision on an Application for a Waste Licence**

*Licensee:* **Bord na Móna Plc  
Drehid Waste Management Facility  
In the townlands of Parsonstown, Loughnacush, Kilkeaskin,  
Drummond, Timahoe West, Coolcarrigan,  
Killinagh Lower & Killinagh Upper  
County Kildare**

*Register of Licence No:* **W0201-02**

The Directors considered the following documentation: Proposed Decision issued on 7 November 2008; five third party objections; one first party objection; three submissions on objections; report and recommendations of the Technical Committee, Office of Climate, Licensing and Resource Use.

A copy of the licence application was tabled.

L Burke gave a verbal presentation.

### **Technical Committee Report**

The Directors noted the Technical Committee Report and approved the recommendations of the Technical Committee, with the following amendments:

- A.1 Clarify the recommended time frames in relation to the outage of the landfill gas flare
- A.2 The Directors did not approve the Technical Committee's recommendation to delete Condition 1.5. The Directors recommended that a condition detailing hours of waste acceptance and operation are included in the licence
- A.5 The Directors accepted the recommendation of the Technical Committee in relation to Condition 8.1.1  
Amend Condition 8.1.2 to read: The pre-treatment referred to in Condition 8.1.1 must include *diversion or* treatment of Biodegradable Municipal Waste (BMW) *in line with any published EPA Guidance.*
- A.12 Clarify the unit of measure of the capacity of the landfill

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Bord Na Móna Plc for their facility at Drehid Waste Management Facility, in the townlands of Parsonstown, Loughnacush, Kilkeaskin, Drummond, Timahoe West, Coolcarrigan, Killinagh Lower & Killinagh Upper, County Kildare, Register of Licence No W0201-02, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
