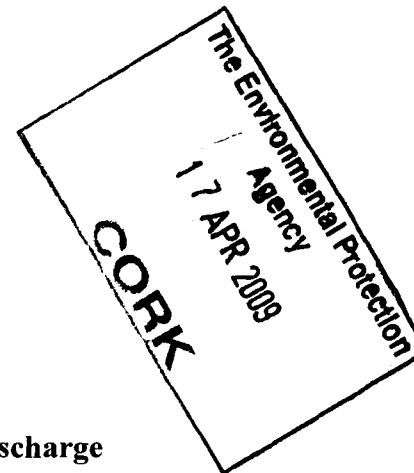
With respect to your letter of 3rd April last I write to inform you that the Site Notice has been put back up in Ladysbridge since the 9th April last.
