I acknowledge receipt of your letter regarding the above, which was received by the Agency on 9<sup>th</sup> March 2009.

Your request for a Technical Amendment of your licence has been assessed.

I am to advise you that the requested technical amendment has been refused. It is considered that a licence review is required to accommodate the requested changes on the basis of the scale and scope of the requested change of activities and to address the emissions associated with the proposed activities, which were not considered by the Agency prior to granting the existing waste licence.

I also advise, that should you intend to proceed with the proposed new activity you should seek a review of Waste Licence Register No W0079-01 under the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2008.
