I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at the former racecourse, Greenpark, Dock Road, Limerick. I am directed to advise you of failures of compliance with Article 6 and 7 of the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, specifically:

The notice published in respect of the application contravenes Article 6 (c) and 6 (d) and 6 (e) of the regulations.

The notice as erected or fixed on the facility, or premises, contravenes Article 7 (3) (b) of the regulations.

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Article 8 of the regulations, to

Publish an amended newspaper notice in accordance with Article 6 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations. The notice should be published in the newspaper that carried the original notice.

Replace the existing site notice with an amended site notice that complies with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations. The amended notice must be maintained at a location complying with Article 7 of said regulations for a period of two months.

An amended written notice should be given to the relevant planning authority in accordance with Article 9 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

The above requirements should be carried out within two weeks of the date of this notice.

The Agency further requires you to submit the following evidence in relation to compliance with the above requirement:

An original of the newspaper, and two copies of the relevant page of the newspaper, in which the amended notice has been published.

An original and two copies of both a letter stating the date on which the amended site notice was fixed and a drawing showing its location on the site.

An original and two copies of the text of the amended notice erected or fixed in, accordance with Article 7.

An original and two copies of the amended written notice to the relevant planning authority, in accordance with Article 9.

The evidence requested should be submitted within two of the date of this notice, in the form of a one original plus two copies. In addition submit two copies in electronic searchable PDF format on a CD-ROM to the Agency. Please note that all drawings/maps should not exceed A3 in size.
