RE: Clerical Amendment to Licence Register Number W0109-01, held by Clare County Council, for Central Waste Management Facility, Ballyduff Beg, Inagh, Co. Clare.

Clare County Council (CCC) was first granted a Waste Licence by the Environmental Protection Agency on the 13th June 2001, bearing Reg. No. W0109-01, subsequently this licence was the subject of a Desktop Amendment ('Amendment A') on the 19th December 2005 and a Technical Amendment ('Amendment B') on the 17th July 2008.

Amendment B was issued following a request from Clare County Council to facilitate a change to the way in which the working face of the landfill is specified under the licence. The wording of Condition 5.5.(b) in Amendment B is as follows:

'The working face of the landfill shall be no more than 2.5 meters in height after compaction, no more than 25 meters wide, with a total maximum area of 625m³ and have a slope of no greater than 1 in 3'.

The purpose of this Amendment ('Amendment C') is to rectify a clerical error in the wording of Condition 5.5.(b) in Amendment B. The error that occurred referred to the maximum area of the working face of the landfill as 625m³ (which is a volumetric measurement). This clerical amendment will correct the maximum area of the working face of the landfill to 625m².

Condition 5.5.(b) will read as follows:

'The working face of the landfill shall be no more than 2.5 meters in height after compaction, no more than 25 meters wide, with a total maximum area of 625m² and have a slope of no greater than 1 in 3'.

Recommendation:

I recommend that the licence amendment be approved as set out in the attached recommended Clerical Amendment. Such an amendment does not result in the relevant requirements of Section 40(4) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2008 ceasing to be satisfied.
