**Re: Restoration of Former Quarry at Grannagh, Kilmacow, Co Kilkenny
Application to the Environmental Protection agency for Waste Licence**

We write to formally advise that we have today forward an application to the Environmental protection agency for a waste licence for the continued operation of its existing waste facility at Grannagh, Kilmacow, Co Kilkenny (National Grid Reference 5216N, 0709W)

The principal activity is Class 4 of the Fourth Schedule (recycling or reclamation of organic materials). Other activities include Class 13 of the Fourth Schedule (temporary storage pending recycling) and Class 2 of the Fourth Schedule-Recycling and Reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (Including composting and other biological processes) .

will, as soon as practicable after receipt by the agency, be available for inspection or purchase at the headquarters of the agency.
