Re: Notice in accordance with Regulation 12 of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007.

Dear Ms Power,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a Waste Water Discharge Licence relating to the agglomeration of **Clondulane**. I am directed to advise you of a failure of compliance with Regulation 11 of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007.

The site notice, as inspected on the 10th July 2009, included a reference to a different agglomeration.

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Regulation 12(b)(ii) of the regulations:

- to erect or fix a site notice in accordance with Regulation 11 of Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007 for a period of one month from the 5th August 2009.


The Agency further requires you to submit the following evidence in relation to compliance with the above requirement:

- Confirm in writing that the site notice has been erected or fixed in accordance with Regulation 11.
- A copy of the notice and dated/verified photograph of notice in-situ.

The evidence requested should be submitted within **two weeks of the date of this notice**, in the form of a one original plus two copies. In addition, please submit one copy in an electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM to the Agency. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.
