Dear Ms Power

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste water discharge licence in respect of Agglomeration Named Innishannon. I am directed to advise you of a failure of compliance with Regulation 9 of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007.

No site notice was in evidence at the locations specified on the map in the licence application during a site notice inspection on 15th July 2009.

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Regulation 12 of the regulations,

- to erect a site notice as required in compliance with Regulation 11, as specified in your licence application and for a period of 1 month from 23rd July 2009.

The Agency further requires you to submit evidence in relation to compliance with the above requirement:

- Copy of the notice and dated/verified photograph of notice in-situ.

The evidence requested should be submitted within **2 weeks of the date of this notice**, in the form of one original copy plus one further copy. In addition, please submit one copy in an electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM to the Agency. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.
