Hi Denise,

The answers to your queries are below in red.

1. What is the capacity of all cells, whether built or not which have full consent i.e both a waste licence and planning permission

Can you provide this figure in m³ and tonnage with the compaction rate.

A. The remaining capacity is approximately 62,304 m³ representing 79,267 tonnes. The compaction rate is .786 tonnes per m³.

2. What is the predicted date of closure?

A. The landfill is currently closed, once re-opened approx October 2009, it is estimated to take 24 months at licenced limit (40,000 tpa) until closure (Approx October 2011).

3. What forms the basis for the closure e.g - Current intake / Capacity or
 Licence limit / Capacity or
 Planning stipulation

A. The licence limit - Every effort is made to achieve the licenced tonnage limit, however changes to waste policy/landfill levy/increased recycling/economic activity/other landfill gate fees all effect the actual tonnage received.
