Inspector's Report

The Directors noted the Inspector's Report and Addendum A to the Inspector's Report.

Under Addendum A of the Inspector's Report it was noted that the date in the final sentence of the 1st paragraph should be amended to read 4^{th} June 2009. It was further noted that the Directors agreed with the recommendation of the Inspector not to establish a 'community fund'. It was noted that the Board recommended that the 2^{nd} sentence in the penultimate paragraph should be amended to read: I do not consider the *nature* of the activity proposed *justifies* the establishment of a 'community fund'.

Recommended Decision

Condition

- 1.7.2 Amend to read: The facility may be operated only between the hours of 07:30 to 18:30 Monday to Friday inclusive (excluding Public Holidays), and 07:30 to 14:00 on Saturdays, unless otherwise agreed by the Agency.
- 3.14.2 Amend final sentence to read: The location of all monitoring boreholes shall be subject to reassessment and agreement by the Agency every three years, *or as otherwise requested by the Agency*.

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to BUCHPA Limited for their facility at Kilmartin, Coynes Cross, Newcastle, Co Wicklow, Register of Licence No. W0252-01, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
