Dear Ewa Babiarczyk,

Waste Licence 9-1 was issued in February 2000 with an annual limit to the tonnages to be deposited, I have not seen an overall limit for M3 stipulated in that licence. The Facility's Annual Environmental Reports, during the 9-1 & some of 9-2 authorised phase, (Jan 2000- April 2004), where waste was deposited in the old landfill, state from weighbridge records that 1,020,586 Tonnes of waste were placed in Balleally. The then used conversion rate of 0.8Tonnes per m3 was used which equates to 1,275,732 m3 capacity used.

Waste Licence 9-2 was issued in Jan 2003, for the newly engineered cells with a limit of 1.04 million tonnes or 1.29 m3 of void space for waste placement. The Facility's Annual Environmental Reports, during the 9-2 authorised phase, (April 2004- July 2009), where waste was deposited in the new cells, state from weighbridge records that 727,303 Tonnes of waste were placed in Balleally. The conversion rate of 0.8Tonnes per m3 was used which equates to 909,128 m3 capacity used.

This leaves 312,697 tonnes or 380,872 m3 of authorised capacity remaining to the end of the landfill operation. Recent surveys of remaining void space indicate that this will not be exceeded and that there may not be this capacity remaining.

So in summary

Over Licence period 9-1	1,275,732m3 of void space was filled.
Over Licence Period 9-2, to July 2009	909,128m3 of void space was filled.
Total Space Filled over authorised life of facility to date	2,184,860m3.
Remaining authorised void space under licence 9-2	380,872m3.

Hi Mortimer,

Thank you very much for your response, however I would like to clarify that by the **total quantity of waste to be placed at the landfill (over authorised life of the facility)**, we mean the **total space between the formation levels of a landfill to the final profile expressed in cubic metres**.

In other words, it is the total space that has been filled with waste from the start of an authorised by a waste licence landfill operation until now **plus** the space that remains to be filled with waste to the end of the landfill operation.

Your response refers to the capacity authorised by the licence Reg. No. W0020-02. Could you please include the capacity authorised by the first licence in your calculations?
