I refer to your letter dated 27th July 2009 requesting information on the total quantity of waste to be placed at the landfill (over the authorised life of the facility). Monaghan County Council was granted it's landfill license (W0020-01) on December 7th 2001. Since December 7th 2001 when our licence became operational the following quantities of waste have been landfilled on site. These figures were obtained from our landfilling records:

In relation to landfill capacity remaining at the Scotch Corner facility our Consultants RPS have estimated that the landfill capacity remaining is as follows:

Based on the quantity of waste landfilled to date (as per Table 1) and the remaining capacity at the facility (as per Table 2), the total quantity of waste to be placed at the landfill (over the authorised life of the facility) is calculated as

847,394 tonnes (i.e. 260,478 tonnes + 586,916 tonnes)
