Mr. P.J. Carey submitted details in relation to phase 3 only; however, if possible could you forward the total quantity of waste to be placed at the landfill (over authorised life of the facility) i.e. the total space between the formation levels of a landfill to the final profile expressed in cubic metres.

In other words, it is the total space that has been filled with waste from the start of an authorisation by a waste licence until now **plus** the space that remains to be filled with waste to the end of the landfill operation.
