Hi Josephine,

The following capacity details were agreed with Andrew Lawless from Wicklow County today:

- Rampare landfill was first licensed by W0066-01 on the 15th April 2002.
- As per AER 33,299 tonnes was placed in Rampare LF from 2002 - 2005 (older landfill).
- The extension dealt with under W0066-02 was started in Jan 2006.
- W0066-02 also permitted total waste quantity increase from 11,500 to 50,000 tpa.
- 128,770 tonnes has been placed in the extension from 2006 to the end of July 2009.
- The capacity of the extension is 320,000m3.
- A compaction rate of 0.8 tonnes/cum is used to convert from tonnes to cubic metres.
- Total waste placed in the old landfill from 2002 to closure was 33,299 tonnes (41,623.75m3).
- Total waste placed in the extension from 2006 - end July = 128,770 tonnes (160,962m3)
- Total capacity remaining in the extension = 159,037.5m3.
- Total quantity of waste to be placed at the landfill over the life time of the facility = 361,623.75 m3 = 361,624m3.
