re: Notice in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Mr O'Brien

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence review relating to a facility at Ballyphehane, Curraghconway, Inchisarsfield, South City Link Road, Cork. Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with Article 12 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

You are therefore requested, in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the regulations, to take the steps and supply the information detailed below:

ARTICLE 12 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

Composting

1. It is noted that the most recent Article 14(2)(b)(ii) response, received on the 13th May 2009, makes reference to a proposed limit for the maximum quantity of green waste for composting of 2,400m³ at any one time. In relation to this proposed increase provide:
 - (i) A description of the leachate collection system in place for the compost facility/area.
 - (ii) An assessment of the maximum quantity of green waste that can be composted on the existing impermeable slab (include details of any assumptions made).
 - (iii) Details of any proposed additional works required to ensure that the proposed maximum quantity of green waste can be composted at the facility without causing any significant nuisance or pollution.
 - (iv) Clarification of how the composting process will be managed to minimise and/or manage emissions.

Storm Water/Sewer Network Plan

2. Provide an updated site plan clearly showing the facility storm water/trade effluent sewer network. This plan should identify the location of all existing and proposed interceptors.



Your reply to this notice should include a revised non-technical summary which reflects the information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.

In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.

Please supply the information in the form of a one (1) original plus one (1) copy in hardcopy format by **28th October 2009**. In addition please submit two (2) copies of the requested information in electronic searchable PDF format on a CD-ROM to the Agency. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.
