
The Agency considered your submissions on the applications, in accordance with the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2008, before making the proposed decision.

The notification and the accompanying copy of the proposed decision, set out the details of the proposed decisions, in accordance with Section 42 of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2008 and the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

It is important to note that any objection to a proposed decision/request for an oral hearing **must be received by the Agency before the expiration of the appropriate period as specified in the accompanying notification.** An objection/request for an oral hearing must be made on-line on the Agency's website at www.epa.ie or by sending the objection or request by prepaid post to the Agency, or by leaving the objection or request with an employee of the Agency at the Headquarters of the Agency in Wexford during office hours, i.e. 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday to Friday.

Please note that the objection period ends on 15th November 2009. As the offices of the Agency are closed on that day, in accordance with Article 17 (1) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2008, the latest date for receipt of an objection is extended to 5.00 pm on 16th November 2009.
