4. Recommended Decision on a Review of a Waste Licence

(i) EPA initiated review of 25 landfill licences

The Directors considered a Memorandum from the OCLR detailing the background to the initiation of 25 landfill licence reviews by the Agency in June 2009. B Meaney, Senior Inspector, OCLR, outlined the reasons for the licence reviews as detailed in the Memorandum dated 31 August 2009.

Template - Recommended Decision

Following discussion, the Directors noted and approved the following modifications to the template for Agenda Items 3(i)-(xxv) inclusive.

Introduction

Amend the Introduction to include comments on the reasons for the review of the licence.

Condition

- 8.3.1 Alternative 8.1.1 Amend to read: Unless otherwise as may be specified by the Agency, the following limits shall apply:
 - (i) From 1 July 2010 to 1 July 2013 inclusive, measured on a calendar year basis, or in 2010 and 2013 part thereof,
 - (ii) From 1 July 2013 to 1 July 2016 inclusive, measured on a calendar year basis, or in 2013 and 2016 part thereof,
 - (iii) From 1 July 2016, measured on a calendar year basis, or in 2016 part thereof,
- 8.3.2 Amend to allow agreement, subject to the Review of the waste licences and clarification from the Agency's legal advisor. It was noted that the Directors requested that the OCLR liaise with the OEE and develop an EPA Guidance document in relation to the review of a waste licence for landfills asap.
- 8.4.2 Amend to allow the Agency agree an alternative if there is a protocol based on process parameters Link to Schedule D on Waste Monitoring
- 8.4.4 Amend to read: In the case of bio stabilised residual wastes odours are minimised and that the respiration activity after four days is $<10mg\ O_2/g\ DM$ until 1 January 2016 and $<7mg\ O_2/g\ DM$ thereafter.
- 8.4.6 Delete final sentence.
- 10 Clarify the requirement for CEN/ISO standards.

EMP & LEMP - Combine the two conditions relating to the Environmental Management Plan (EMP) and the Landfill Environmental Management Plan (LEMP) - OCLR to clarify the wording.

Item - 17

Daily & Intermediate Cover: Bio-stabilised residual waste shall only be used as landfill cover where it has been stabilised in accordance with *Condition 8.4.4*, complies with any requirements with the Agency.

D Waste Monitoring

Amend Parameter in relation to Bio-stabilised residual waste to read: Respiration activity after four days

Amend Frequency in relation to Bio-stabilised residual waste to allow for frequency to be reduced if an alternative protocol is agreed by the Agency under Condition 8.4.2.
