Please note that the objection period ends on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2009. As the offices of the Agency are closed on that day, in accordance with Article 17 (1) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2008, the latest date for receipt of an objection is extended to 5.00 pm on 16<sup>th</sup> November 2009.
