The Agency is prohibited from considering any objection which does not fulfil the requirements of Section 42 of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2008. As your correspondence does not fulfil those requirements, for the reasons set out below, the Agency cannot consider it.

Section 42(3) of the Acts Objection received after the expiration of the appropriate period,
i.e. 5pm on 16/11/09

Section 42(4) of the Acts Objection not accompanied by the appropriate fee, i.e. €500
