

Dear Mr. Cullinan,

I refer to your application for review of your Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control licence, licence review application Reg. No. P0467-02 which was initiated by the Agency on 28th March 2008.

It is noted that you have not responded, to the satisfaction of the Agency, to the Agency's letter of 21st January 2009 requesting the submission of information in support of your licence review application in accordance with Section 90 of the Environmental Protection Agency Acts 1992 to 2007.

I am to inform you that the documentation submitted to date in support of your licence review application does not contain the necessary information for the Agency to satisfy itself in accordance with Section 83(5)(a) of the EPA Acts 1992 to 2007 or to make a decision on the licence review application in the absence of the information.

With a view to advancing this application for determination by the Agency, the information requested under previous correspondence, referred to above, should be submitted to the Agency within six weeks of the date of this letter. Should you fail to provide the information requested to the satisfaction of the Agency, the Agency may, in accordance with Section 90(2)(a)(i) of the EPA Acts 1992 to 2007, inform you of the Agency's refusal to grant a revised licence.

Your prompt attention to this matter is therefore requested.
