re : Notice in accordance with Article 16(1) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Ms Mulhall,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Hi-Volt Ireland Limited, Ballyduff, Thurles, Co. Tipperary and to thank you for submitting the necessary information which has enabled the Agency to confirm that the application complies with the requirements of Articles 12 and 13 of the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

The stage has now been reached where the Agency is giving detailed consideration to the application and to complete this task the following information, particulars and evidence are required in accordance with Article 16(1) of the Regulations.

Please provide complete answers to each question.

ARTICLE 16(1) - FURTHER INFORMATION, PARTICULARS AND EVIDENCE

- Provide details of the proposed arrangements to test the compatibility of waste oils prior to the addition and mixing of these waste oils in the bunded oil tanks. Expand on attachment H.3.
- Provide details on the proposed timeframe for accepting waste oils, drummed flammable liquid waste and gases in pressure containers to the facility.
- State in non-technical terms the nature and source of drummed flammable liquids and gases in pressure containers. In the context of Table H.1 (i) of the application, separate out the EWC codes for these materials from the more specific waste oil and oil filters waste, and generally expand on the table into more distinct waste types.
- Provide a revised site plan illustrating the proposed storage location of drummed flammable liquid wastes and gases in pressure containers at the facility. Provide a copy of the procedure, or outline of a procedure, for control and operation of the proposed storage arrangements to be put in place at the facility for such wastes. The procedure or outline should state what published



conventions/guidelines would be followed to ensure safe and effective segregation and storage of these wastes.

- The applicant shall expand on Section L.2 in the application form and provide details of how the applicant meets the requirements of Section 40(7)(b) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2008 in the context of hazardous waste management generally and waste oils, flammable wastes and gases in pressure containers specifically. Outline proposals to ensure all personnel employed by the applicant and assigned tasks relating to waste oils and drummed flammable liquid wastes receive the appropriate training. Outline the content of such training. State the qualifications and experience necessary to manage the hazardous waste analysis, blending, segregation, storage, dispatch and other procedures.
- Complete tables H.1 (i) and H.1 (ii) for off-site recovery, reuse or recycling and off site disposal. Outline in general terms the proposed disposal/recovery route(s) for waste oils following bulking up and storage at the facility. State how waste acceptance procedures at the ultimate treatment facility will affect management, storage and analysis of waste oils at your proposed facility. Identify in general terms the proposed disposal/recovery route(s) for drummed flammable liquid wastes following storage at the facility.



It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.

Your reply to this notice should include a revised non-technical summary, which reflects the further information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information impinges on the relevant non-technical summary.

Please supply the information in the form of a one (1) original plus one (1) copy in hardcopy format within **six weeks** of the date of this notice. In addition submit two (2) copies of the requested information to the Agency in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.
