I refer to our recent meeting at EPA, Richview, attended by;



Gypsum Industries sought a meeting to discuss possible options for the regulation of a proposed new activity at the site of the licensed activity. Gypsum Industries Limited sought clarification as to whether waste gypsum could be brought back on to the site and disposed of, or recovered, on the site, and whether this proposed activity could be catered for by way of a Technical Amendment of the existing IPPC licence.

Following our discussions, the EPA clarified that the proposed new activity could not be brought into regulation by way of a Technical Amendment because what was proposed constituted a new class of activity, and in order that the proposed new activity could be regularised, a review of the existing IPPC licence would be required.

I hope that you found the meeting useful in the clarification of the matter, and I would be glad to discuss it further with you if you have any further questions.
