TRANSFER OF A WASTE LICENCE

Decision of the Agency, under Section 47(5) of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2008

Waste Licence Register No: W0185-01

The Agency, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2008, for the reasons hereinafter set out, hereby transfers waste licence register number W0185-01 from Cedar Resource Management Limited, Parkview House, Beech Hill, Clonskeagh, Dublin 4, to Rilta Environmental Limited, 402 Greenogue Business Park, Rathcoole, County Dublin, Waste Licence Register No W0185-01 licenses the carrying on of the waste activities set out below at Site No. 14A1, Greenogue Business Park, Rathcoole, County Dublin subject to twelve Conditions, as set out in the waste licence.

Licensed Waste Disposal Activities in accordance with the Third Schedule to the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2008

Class 7.	Physico-chemical treatment not referred to elsewhere in this Schedule (including evaporation, drying and calcination) which results in final compounds or mixtures which are disposed of by means of any activity referred to in paragraphs 1. to 10. of this Schedule:
	This activity relates to the shredding of waste materials, including, household hazardous waste containers and metals, plastics, card and paper. Physico-chemical treatment may be carried out on effluents to meet discharge criteria.
Class 11.	Blending or mixture prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule.
	This activity relates to bulking-up of waste on-site prior to shipment of waste for disposal off-site.
Class 12.	Repackaging prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule.
	This activity relates to the baling and repackaging of various waste types prior to disposal off-site.
Class 13.	Storage prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where the waste concerned is produced.
	This activity relates to the storage of hazardous and non-hazardous waste at the facility prior to disposal off-site.

Licensed Waste Disposal Activities in accordance with the Fourth Schedule to the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2008

Class 2.	Recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological transformation processes):
	This activity relates to the recycling of various organic substances including, wood, paper/cardboard, textile materials and vegetable oils.
Class 3.	Recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds:
	This activity relates to the dismantling, shredding, baling and recycling of various metal wastes.
Class 4.	Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials:
	This activity is limited to the reclamation of refrigerator gasses.
Class 11.	Use of waste obtained from any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule:
	This activity is to make provision for the acceptance on-site for transfer to an appropriate facility of waste that has been obtained from any activity referred to previously in the Schedule.
Class 12.	Exchange of waste for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule:
	This activity refers to the exchange of certain waste types and their packaging for further processing off-site
Class 13.	Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced:
	This activity is limited to the storage of waste at the facility prior to off-site recovery.

In accordance with Section 47(6) of the Acts, Rilta Environmental Limited is deemed to have assumed and accepted all liabilities, requirements and obligations provided for in or arising under the licence, regardless of how and in respect of what period, including a period prior to the transfer of the licence, they may arise.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Pursuant to Section 47(5)(a) of the Acts, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Rilta Environmental Limited is entitled to be regarded as a fit and proper person to be granted a like waste licence. Pursuant to Section 47(5)(b) of the Acts, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Rilta Environmental Limited has made adequate financial provision to discharge the financial commitments or liabilities that will be entered into or incurred in carrying on each of the activities to which the licence relates, or in consequence of ceasing to carry on any of those activities. In reaching this decision the Agency has considered the application and supporting documentation received from the joint applicants and the report of its inspector.
