Observations regarding Waste Licence Application Reference No. W0274-01 by ADPower Roscommon Ltd.

Dear Sonja,

In response to your letter dated 15th January 2010, we have studied the recent application to the Environmental Protection Agency by ADPower Roscommon Ltd. for a Waste Licence for their proposed facility at Ballinphuill, Tibohine, Castlerea, Co. Roscommon and make the following observations regarding their submission.

There appears to be a substantial inconsistency in the details of the waste streams ADPower Roscommon Ltd. intended to accept at their proposed facility as noted in their Waste Licence application to the EPA and those for which Planning Permission has been granted by Roscommon County Council. I draw your attention to Condition 11 of Planning Permission Reference No. PD08-656 for the development which limits the materials to be supplied to the development as follows:

The raw materials to be supplied to the development shall be as stated in the submission made to the planning authority on 6th August 2008.

Reason: In the interests of orderly development

The submission noted above was made in response to a Further Information request seeking more information regarding the raw materials required by the development. Their response indicated that the raw materials to be supplied would be rape seed, oaten, barley and wheaten straw. Noting the above it is the opinion of Roscommon County Council, Planning Authority that Condition 11 for the development does not extend to permit the facility to accept the waste streams detailed in the current Waste Licence application to the EPA.
