## **Recommended Determination**

### Introduction

Amend 4<sup>th</sup> paragraph to read: The licence review was required to facilitate the setting of a standard for processed fuel oil produced at this facility for use only in the asphalt/quarry sector as a substitute for heavy fuel oil.

Delete final paragraph of the Introduction

#### Condition

- 6.15 Amend to read: A report on the test programme shall be submitted to the Agency within one month of completion *for approval*.
- 8.10.2 Amend to read: Processed waste oil produced in the Waste Oil Treatment System *following approval by the Agency of the test programme in accordance with Condition 6.1.5* from waste oils specified in Table A.3 Schedule A ....... ... as a substitute for HFO.
- 8.10.3 Amend to read: Waste oil which does not meet the criteria *specified in Condition 8.10.2* must be disposed of/recovered off-site in accordance with appropriate National and European legislation and protocols.

11.12 Amend to include a condition requiring that the certificate of compliance should as a minimum state that the processed fuel oil is 'processed fuel oil' and indicate the results of sampling and analysis of the batch.

#### **Financial Charges**

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Rilta Environmental Limited, for their facility at Block 402, Grant's Drive, Greenogue Business Park, Rathcoole, Co Dublin, Register of Licence No W0192-03, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
