Re: Objection to the proposed decision of the Agency on a waste licence application by Molaisín Compost Limited in respect of a facility at Molaisín Compost Limited, Kilmolash, Cappoquin Co. Waterford

Dear Liz,

I refer to your later dated 16th February 2010 regarding an objection to the decision to grant a licence to Molaisín Compost Limited. Mr. Cummins, the objector, has lodged a number of complaints in relation to the facility over the past number of years. These have been directly to Waterford County Council and the EPA, never to Molaisín management directly. Waterford County Council have conducted a large number of site visits as a result of these complaints and have never recorded an odour problem on site or in the vicinity of the site. When we receive notification of these complaints we investigate them thoroughly, looking at waste intake records, material movement within the facility and wind direction and have found these complaints to be without merit, the majority of the complaints are made at a time when the wind direction is not going towards Mr Cummins house.
