

Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations SI G84/2007

Dear Sirs,

In accordance with Section 37 (1) of the above regulations Cork County Council hereby requests an amendment to the following condition of the above licences.

Section 4.17. Habitats

The licensee shall, within twelve months of the date of grant of this licence, undertake an assessment of the predicted impacts on the Cork Harbour Special Area of Conservation (4030) arising as a result of the discharges from the agglomeration. This assessment should be carried out in accordance with the provisions of the Habitats Directive 92/43/EEC, have regard to the sites conservation objectives and identify appropriate mitigation responses for any predicted impacts. The assessment shall be submitted as part of the AER.

Cork County Council requests that the submission of this assessment with the AER is deferred until all the discharges entering the harbour are licensed, as the brief for the independent consultant, for the assessment, can be clearly identified when all the licenses for the discharges into the harbour are issued.
