**RE: Murray Waste Recycling Ltd.**

Dear Ms. Kelly

I refer to our telephone conversation of 29 March 2010 in relation to Murray Waste Recycling Ltd (MWR) and their pending waste licence application. On behalf of MWR, Fehily Timoney & Co. (FTC) wishes to advise the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) of our client's intention to request an increase in the quantity of waste accepted at the facility from 24,500 tpa to circa 55,000 tpa.

The proposed addition in tonnages will mean that the threshold of 25,000 tpa will be surpassed; hence, an EIS will be required to be submitted. FTC understands that there will also be an additional fee of €2,000 will be required in respect of the application.

It is envisaged that the additional information will be submitted to the Agency some time in September 2010.

FTC would be grateful if the proposed decision on the waste licence application would not be granted until the EIS has been reviewed by the Agency.
