
I refer to your recent visit to Scotch Corner Landfill and the ICW at Castle Leslie in Glaslough and also my subsequent email dated 27th January 2010. (copy of which is attached)

Our landfill inspector Eamon Merriman outlined in a site meeting following your recent visit that under our current licence, Monaghan County Council is precluded from "importing" leachate from the historic landfill. As you know under our ICW proposal we would intend collecting all leachate from both the historic landfill and the current facility in a sump chamber located within the boundaries of the current facility prior to distribution to the proposed ICW for treatment via pumping. (as can be seen from the draft ICW site layout attached)

As outlined previously Monaghan County Council has commenced the process of regulating the historic landfill through the Waste Management (Certification of Historic Unlicensed Waste Disposal and Recovery Activity) Regulations 2008 and we have done quite a bit of work in this regard as the historic landfill at Scotch Corner was one of the project sites selected under the Department of Environment, Heritage and Local Government Historic Landfills pilot Project Grant Scheme. A Tier 1 and Tier 2 assessment has been carried out under the EPA Code of Practice – Environmental Risk Assessment for Unregulated Waste Disposal Sites.

Monaghan County Council is requesting that under our current review, the EPA amend licence W0020-01 such that Monaghan County Council would be permitted to import leachate from the historic landfill to the current facility to facilitate leachate collection for subsequent treatment via the proposed ICW. Monaghan Council obviously wishes to avoid having to go through another costly licence review to address this particular issue and we feel that this could be addressed under our current review. We look forward to hearing from you in this regard and should you require any clarification or any further information please contact me on 047-30592.

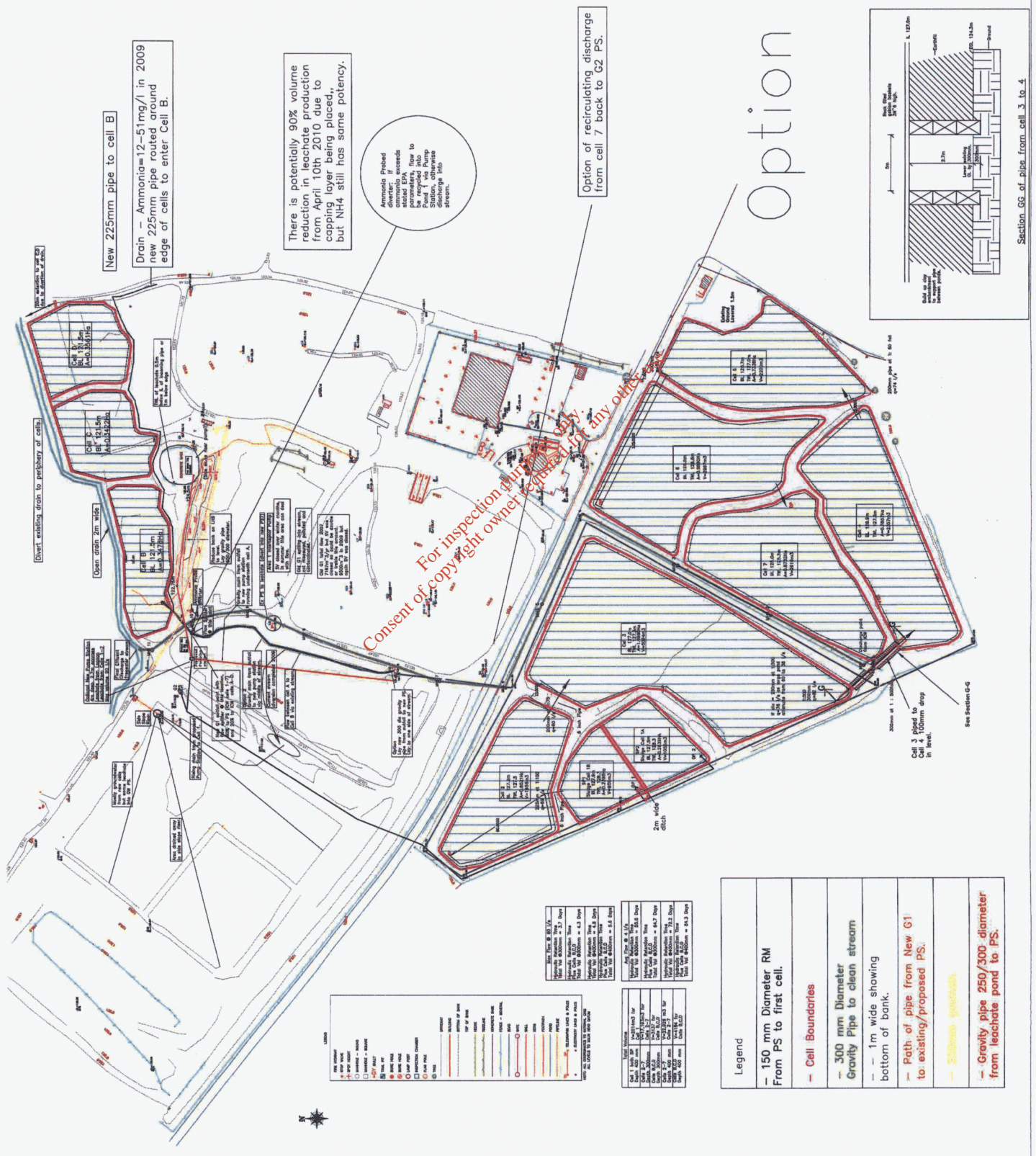
Eva/Brian,

Hope you are well and that you enjoyed your recent trip to Monaghan to view the ICW at Scotch Corner. After you left the Scotch Corner last Thursday we had a further meeting with Eamon Merriman to discuss further our proposals in relation to our ICW proposal to treat leachate from both the current landfill and the historic landfill. Eamon indicated that under our current license we are precluded from "importing" leachate from the historic landfill for treatment and in order for us to progress our ICW proposal our licence would need to be amended to take this into account. I know yesterday Eva that you indicated that the EPA were likely to conclude our current license review with the information presently available and that the ICW proposal which would involve importing leachate in from the old landfill would have to be addressed under a further licence review.

Would the EPA reconsider the possibility of addressing this issue in our current licence review (W0020-01) as having to initiate a further licence review could possibly be an expensive exercise which in the current economic climate is something we would like to avoid if at all possible. We appreciate that the current review has been going on for a considerable amount of time but we would appreciate if our ICW proposal and the requirement to import leachate from the historical landfill is something which could be incorporated within our current review.

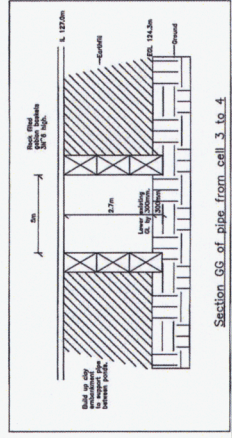
