re: Notice in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Mr. Leahy,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Mr. Binman, Luddenmore, Grange, Kilmallock, Co. Limerick. Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with Article 12 and Article 13 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.

You are therefore requested, in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the regulations, to take the steps and supply the information detailed below:

ARTICLE 12 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. With regard to waste water treatment plant effluent quality, an Article 14(2)(b)(ii) reply dated 19th January 2010 stated 'trials will be completed in January 2010 to measure and compare the quality of the effluent direct from the clarifier and from the storage tank (prior to pumping to the tanker for off-site disposal). Provide an update of these trials.
- 2. Provide results for the most recent groundwater monitoring events carried out on site for the upgradient and downgradient monitoring points, GW1 and GW2.
- 3. Provide information on the percolation area associated with the waste water treatment plant e.g. design specification. Provide information showing that the percolation area is/will be appropriately constructed and sized to deal with emissions from the waste water treatment plant.
- 4. Provide a map showing the location of all local sensitive receptors. On the map show the distance to each of the receptors.
- 5. Assess the capacity of the facility to process the requested waste tonnages (200,000 tonnes per annum). Assess the capacity to process waste with regard to the current and requested site hours of operation.

ARTICLE 13 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. Where necessary update the EIS documents, having regard to the information requested under 'Article 12 Compliance Requirements' above.

Your reply to this notice should include a revised non-technical summary (Application Form and EIS) which reflects the information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.

In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.

Please supply the information in the form of a one (1) original plus one (1) copy in hardcopy format within **three weeks** of the date of this notice. In addition submit sixteen (16) copies of the requested information to the Agency in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.
