I refer to the above and to your correspondence dated 13<sup>th</sup> April 2010, which was received by the Agency on the 14<sup>th</sup> April 2010.

I wish to acknowledge the contents of your letter, which states that Murray Waste Recycling Limited wishes to increase the quantity of waste acceptance at the facility to 55,000 tonnes per annum.

In relation to the above, I am to advise that along with an EIS, a revised waste licence application will need to be submitted to reflect any operational, infrastructural or waste acceptance alterations resultant of the proposed increase in annual tonnage intake. Additionally, as stated in your letter, a further fee of €2,000 will apply.

I have attached hereto instructions regarding the number of copies and submission format for the revised application form and EIS.
