4. Recommended Decision on an Application for a Review of a Waste Licence Licensee: Bord na Mona Energy Limited Srahmore & Attavally Bangor-Erris County Mayo Register of Licence No: W0199-02

The Directors considered a recommendation from the Office of Climate, Licensing and Resource Use that the Agency approve the Recommended Decision to grant a Waste Licence. The following documentation was submitted: Recommended Decision, one Third-Party submission and summary report of the Inspector. The Directors noted that this is a review of Waste Licence No. W0199-01, issued by the Agency on 29 October 2004.

A copy of the licence application was available electronically.

Inspector's Report

The Directors noted the Inspector's Report.

Recommended Determination

Introduction

Amend 1st sentence in 4th paragraph to read: All drainage from the site will be collected *in sedimentation lagoons* prior to discharge to local river systems.

Condition

- 1.8.3 Amend to read: Waste shall not be accepted at the facility on *Sundays or* Bank Holidays.
- 3.10.1 Amend to read: *A waste quarantine area shall be provided and maintained at the facility. The peat reception area shall act as a waste inspection area.*
- 3.10.3 Amend to read: Drainage from *the peat reception area and the waste quarantine area* shall be directed to the surface water management system.
- 3.18 Amend 2nd sentence to read: Flows in excess of the design or as otherwise may be agreed *by the Agency*.
- 6.10 Delete this condition.
- 6.11.5 (iii) Amend to read; all new manholes and outfalls are set well back from turning grounds *and* drivers of bog plant do not turn short (over drains) at headlands,
- 6.11.5 (v) Amend to read: outfalls are *blocked or* controlled to minimise silt discharge during cleaning operations,
- 6.11.5 (vii) Amend to read: while ditching, outfalls are blocked and *ditching shall be completed* towards outfall,

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Bord na Mona Energy Limited, for their facility at Srahmore & Attavally, Bangor-Erris, County Mayo, Register of Licence No W0199-02, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
