The Directors considered the following documentation: Proposed Decision issued on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2009; one First Party objection; report and recommendations of the Technical Committee, Office of Climate, Licensing and Resource Use.

A copy of the licence application was available electronically.

**Technical Committee Report**

The Directors noted the Technical Committee Report and approved the recommendations of the Technical Committee with the following amendments:

***Condition 8.1.1 & 8.1.2 Limit on Acceptance of Biodegradable Municipal Waste***

Amend to read:

8.1.2 Limit on acceptance of biodegradable municipal waste

Unless otherwise as may be specified by the Agency, the following limits shall apply:

- (i) From 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2013 inclusive, a maximum of 47% by weight of municipal solid waste (MSW) accepted for disposal to the body of the landfill shall comprise biodegradable municipal waste (BMW), measured on a calendar year basis or, in 2010 and 2013, part thereof,
- (ii) From 1 July 2013 to 30 June 2016 inclusive: a maximum of 30% by weight of MSW accepted for disposal to the body of the landfill shall comprise BMW, measured on a calendar year basis or, in 2013 and 2016, part thereof, and
- (iii) From 1 July 2016, a maximum of 15% by weight of MSW accepted for disposal to the body of the landfill shall comprise BMW, measured on a calendar year basis or, in 2016, part thereof.

**Condition 11.17 Quarterly Reporting**

11.17 Reporting to Demonstrate Compliance with Diversion Targets

The Directors recommended that 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence is amended to read: From *1 July 2010* .... .. calendar year to date.

## **Glossary**

The Directors recommended an amendment to the following definition in the licence glossary of terms:-

***Environmental damage:*** As defined in Council Directive 2004/35/EC on environmental liability with regard to the prevention and remedying of environmental damage.

## **Schedule C.6 Waste Monitoring**

The Directors recommended that the frequency of testing for Bio-stabilised residual waste is amended to every 500 tonnes from each source.

## **Financial Charges**

The Directors recommended that the Financial Charges are updated to reflect the 2010 licence enforcement fees.

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Donegal County Council, for their facility at Ballynacarrick Landfill, Ballynacarrick, Ballintra, County Donegal, Register of Licence No W0024-04, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
