**Technical Committee Report**

The Directors noted the Technical Committee Report and approved the recommendations of the Technical Committee with the following amendments:

**A.2 Condition 3.13.3**

Amend to read:

3.13.4 The licensee shall provide appropriate infrastructure to allow for the removal of dissolved methane from the leachate *if discharged to a sewer network*.  
Renummer the existing condition 3.13.4 as 3.13.5

**A.4 Conditions 5.2.3 & 5.2.7**

Amend to read:

5.2.3 Unless otherwise as may be specified by the Agency, the following limits shall apply:

- (i) From 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2013 inclusive, a maximum of 47% by weight of municipal solid waste (MSW) accepted for disposal to the body of the landfill shall comprise biodegradable municipal waste (BMW), measured on a calendar year basis or, in 2010 and 2013, part thereof,
- (ii) From 1 July 2013 to 30 June 2016 inclusive: a maximum of 30% by weight of MSW accepted for disposal to the body of the landfill shall comprise BMW, measured on a calendar year basis or, in 2013 and 2016, part thereof, and
- (iii) From 1 July 2016, a maximum of 15% by weight of MSW accepted for disposal to the body of the landfill shall comprise BMW, measured on a calendar year basis or, in 2016, part thereof.

#### **A.6 Condition 12.1.1**

The Directors recommended that the Financial Charges are updated to reflect the 2010 licence enforcement fees.

#### **A.7 Schedule A**

The Directors sought clarification on this item. It was noted that the OCLR refer this matter to the OEE for consideration.

#### **Proposed Decision**

##### **Glossary**

The Directors recommended the inclusion of the following definition in the licence glossary of terms:-

***Environmental damage:*** As defined in Council Directive 2004/35/EC on environmental liability with regard to the prevention and remedying of environmental damage.

##### **Condition**

11.8 Reporting to Demonstrate Compliance with Diversion Targets

The Directors recommended that 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence is amended to read: From *1 July 2010* .... .. calendar year to date.

##### **Schedule D.8 Waste Monitoring**

The Directors recommended that the frequency of testing for Bio-stabilised residual waste is amended to every *500* tonnes from each source.

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Offaly County Council, for their facility at Derryclure Landfill, Derryclure, Tullamore, County Offaly, Register of Licence No W0029-03, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
