Introduction

Final paragraph: Move to become penultimate paragraph.

Decision & Reasons for the Decision

Amend 2nd paragraph to read: In reaching this decision the Environmental Protection Agency has had regard to the requirements and objectives of Regulation 6 of the Regulations and has considered the application and supporting documentation *received from the applicant, received from other parties, and the report of its inspector.*

3rd paragraph: Amend to standardise the text of (ii) to the same format as (i).

4.11 Amend to have Toxicity testing carried out as required by the Agency.
