The licensee shall, within six months of the date of grant of this licence, put in place a management plan for the conservation of bats at the site.

- 1.8.1 & 1.8.2 Delete the reference to waste acceptance and operation on Saturdays
- 2.1.2 Delete the final sentence of this condition.

#### Schedule A – Limitations

Table A.2 Amend to read: Expressed in cubic metres and to be *submitted for agreement* by the Agency within 1 month of the date of grant of the licence, but to be restricted to delivering the aims of quarry restoration plan as outlined in the application.

### Schedule C - Control & Monitoring

- C.3.2 Delete requirement for monitoring of Flow and Temperature & associated Note 2.
- Monitoring frequency for all groundwater parameters is to be annually.

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Cork City Council, for their facility at Beaumont Quarry, Churchyard Lane, Ballinlough/Ballintemple, Cork City, Register of Licence No W0141-02, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
