As residents and parents of three asthmatic children, we wish to express our objection to the proposed Waste Licence Application No.WO 274-01 at Ballinphuill, Tibohine,Castlerea, Co Roscommon.

The establishment of such a facility would be a vile and unwelcome intrusion of our country land. Can anyone really guarantee the people of Tibohine, that in that time, our air and water supply will not become polluted with the introduction of such a facility into the area? Can anybody promise us that the gases/fumes and odours, dispersed from this depot and inhaled by the children in the nearby school, will not be harmful to those with and without respiratory problems?
