B.1 Monitoring of Primary Waste Water Discharge

Amend Note 1 to read: The monitoring requirements shall apply from 31<sup>st</sup> March 2012 or upon completion of the proposed WWTP and ancillary works, whichever is sooner.

B.4 Ambient Monitoring

Amend Note 1 to read: Ambient monitoring data is to be submitted to the Agency in accordance with Condition 4.16 of this licence.

Insert new Note 2 to read: The monitoring requirements shall apply from 31<sup>st</sup> March 2012 or upon completion of the proposed WWTP and ancillary works, whichever is sooner.

Amend Monitoring frequency for the listed parameters to quarterly.

# Financial Charges

The Directors recommended that the financial charges are reduced as detailed on the basis that the plant will not be in operation until 31 March 2012.

# > Delete analysis and inspections charges

Following discussion, the Directors approved the recommended decision to grant a licence, as modified, to Cork County Council (Western Division) for the waste water discharge relating to the Baltimore agglomeration, Register of Licence No D0296-01, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence document.
