Re: Objection against the waste licence-Ref No. W0274-01

To whom it concerns,

We wish to submit an objection to the proposed waste licence being granted to AD Power Ltd. for a site at Ballinphuill, Tibohine. Tibohine is a beautiful serene area and our family have lived here for generations. We strongly oppose this application and we do not want waste being brought into the village we know and love. We have grave concerns that the proposed plant will increase traffic on the road and we do not want this. We have concerns for our health and the health of our 3 children because we believe that there is nothing preventing this plant, if built, from being sold in the future and turned into God only knows what. We have protected our children all their lives and we intend to continue to fight this application to ensure their quality of life is not impacted on, and the quality of life of all the generations of Kerranes in this village to come. We are concerned by the location of the site, less than 100 yards from the local National School and we believe that this is not the place to put a waste treatment plant.

We have concerns about the smells and noises that will come from this proposed Biopark and we believe that nobody can guarantee that it will be odourless. Following the meeting in the community centre on Saturday we are still dissatisfied at what AD Power intend to do in this proposed plant. The spokesperson for AD Power was unable to say where exactly the disinfecting of the lorries would take place apart from saying not onsite and this was despite him saying earlier that water from washing the lorries would be treated onsite earlier in the meeting. It is our opinion that there are a lot of inadequacies here and we are not happy. Despite clearly stating in the Environmental Impact Statement that there

would be 8 traffic movements a day, the said there would be 12 on Saturday night and we believe there will be a lot more. We, therefore, find it impossible to believe a thing they say and it is for that reason that we oppose this plant 100%. We do not want it, and we do not need it.
