"This will be an environmentally friendly park that could,
over time, create openings in ice quality jobs"

"With support we can make this happen and create
sustainable jobs in this locality"

Those two quotations are from The Rosemount Herald, of
Tuesday 8th June 2010, and are attributed personally
to 'Local landowner Kevin Flynn'.

However, at a public meeting, in June 2010, on 12th June 10,
he was requested to "stand up and name the jobs".
His reply was "Local farmers who would supply
silage bales," nothing more, no BSc waste
management graduates, no technicians, no
courses. A speaker from the floor had identified
just three jobs that may come on stream.
All local farmers are 'self employed' as far as
the farming part of their livelihood is concerned.

I suggest that Application No W 0274-01 should be refused
by the E.P.A. as the applicant has given no indication
that he intends employing qualified staff.
He described himself as 'a farmer' and did
not claim to hold any qualification in
waste management.
