Re Waste Licence Application No WEL74-01

I object to the granting of above licence on  
the grounds of possible water pollution.

I base my objection on the fact that there  
is a stream which flows under the road outside  
the former Post Office premises and again flows  
under the N5 a hundred yards or so, west of  
Tubehine N.S. and continues north-westward on  
the side of the <sup>proposed</sup> waste plant. It is  
possible that some of the ground & surface  
water around the waste plant may find  
its way into this stream and thence to  
Lough Gara, the source of our domestic  
and drinking water supply.

A further comment I wish to make is ADP  
persists in calling the proposed enterprise a "Bio-Park".  
Of course nothing in a name can effect the  
actual environment but it can project a  
distorted image. 'Park' is defined as "Public  
garden or recreation ground" (a) "Enclosed land of  
a country house" (b) "Parking area", the proposal  
enterprise fits none of these definitions.

'Bio Park' signifies one of those defined above which  
contains only biological matter.
