I refer to the notice received for the Coachford Waste Water Discharge Licence Application on June 2nd last.



The overall date for return of the information requested i.e. any further assessment required in Item 1 and completing Item 2, is July 27th

Cork County Council respectfully requests a two month extension of time to supply this information.
