Condition

5.1 Delete existing condition.

Insert new condition to read: The licensee shall, within three months, prepare and submit to the Agency for its agreement a Project Plan for the Cork *Lower Harbour Sewerage* Scheme that will achieve the following objectives:

- a) achieve improvements in the quality of all discharges from the works;
- b) meet the emission limit values specified in Schedule A: Discharges, of this licence:
- c) give effect to Regulation 2 of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007 (S.I. No.684 of 2007);
- d) reduce Total Nitrogen loadings and priority substances in the discharge to the maximum practicable extent;
- e) cease emissions, discharges or losses of priority hazardous substances
- 5.2 Delete existing condition.

Insert new condition to read: The Project Plan referred to in Condition 5.1 shall as a minimum include:

- a) A Gantt chart or similar, identifying sequences, duration and target completion dates for the major outputs of the project;
- b) An assessment of the integrity of the waste water works;
- c) The improvements as set out in Schedule C: Specified Improvement Programme, of this licence to be completed by 01/01/2015.

5.3 Delete existing condition.

Insert new condition to read: The Project Plan for the Cork Lower Harbour Sewerage Scheme shall be a single integrated plan serving the agglomerations of Cobh (D0054-01), Passage West/Monkstown (D0129-01), Ringaskiddy/Carrigaline/Crosshaven (D0057-01) and Ringaskiddy Village (D0436-01). Discharges and timelines identified under the Project Plan become part of this licence.
