1) There is a contradiction of identity of applicant;
The environmental impact statement (Page 4 paragraphs) names
BioPower Ltd as 'the applicant'
The Application to the Environmental Protection Agency for a
Waste Licence (Page 1 par. 1) declares "AD Power Res. Ltd" to
be the applicant

2) There is a contradiction of capacity between the 'E.I.S.'
and the 'application for licence'.
Page 7 par. 3 of the former states, "The proposed plant will
have a capacity of 20,000 t/a of raw material"
Page 5 of his application attachment #11 states, "The target
is to accept up to 20,000 tonnes per annum of source
separated biodegradable waste, 2,500 tonnes of industrial
non hazardous sludges and 2,499 tonnes of sewage sludges"
This represents a (near) 25% over intake compared
with that indicated on the E.I.S. as being the capacity
of the injector
This fact constitutes a valid reason for rejection
of both the E.I.S. and the application as it is
a statement of deliberate intention to breach
the terms of the E.I.S. + renders the
application non-tenable.
