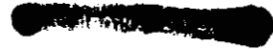

“Suffer little children” is the phrase which came to my mind when I first heard about this application. On further examination of this application I have indeed decided that this group of vulnerable individuals will be the main group to suffer if you grant permission to this application.

As a result of the close proximity to Tibohine National School, this facility will have an affect on the pupils because of emissions from the facility even when they are not outside in the playground.

When asked at the meeting the AD Power representative admitted that it would be the responsibility of the lorry driver to make sure he washed his lorry thoroughly before leaving the site. If the lorry was not fully cleaned it would carry bacteria and other waste materials outside, these particles could find their way into the playground.

The AD Power representative at the public meeting was unable to answer many, if any, of the questions put to him by ordinary people. He did not leave me or many other people at the meeting feeling confident in his expertise. There are too many risks involved in this application for our children’s future health and well being for this application to be granted by the EPA in my opinion.

We have been privileged in Tibohine for several years to have children on holiday from Chernobyl. The children are delicate and speak about the fact that they can not drink milk in their country or eat fresh fruit or vegetables because the land is still contaminated many years later. When one looks at these children and see the price they have paid for wrong

decisions made by previous generations. It is a reminder to us all of the huge responsibility that we have to protect the lives and health of our precious children.
